



Outstanding Registered Electrical Worker Awards Scheme 2017

To Share and be Recognised

Objectives

1. To encourage registered electrical workers to promote work safety culture
2. To arouse work safety awareness among electrical workers
3. To award prizes to registered electrical contractors and registered electrical workers who put a high premium on work safety and implement work safety measures

Categories

Participants may enter the "Individual Category" on an individual basis or the "Team Category" in a team comprising a minimum of two and a maximum of three members in any combination.

(Remarks: (1) Each participant can only sign up for either the Individual Category or the Team Category. (2) Participants in the Team Category are required to specify on the enrolment form the respective stages of testing that they will participate in. Please refer to the section "Format and Assessment" for details of the testing stages of the selection.)

Eligibility and Enrolment

The selection under the Individual Category and the Team Category is only open to registered electrical workers registered with EMSD (irrespective of the registered grade), while the members of each team under the Team Category can come from the same or different registered electrical contractors. Interested parties should complete the enrolment form and submit it by mail/fax to the Electricity Legislation Division of EMSD (Address: 7/F, EMSD Headquarters Building, 3 Kai Shing Street, Kowloon; Fax: 2895 4929) on or before 8 September 2017. Format and Assessment

The selection consists of three stages of testing. Individual participants or one member assigned by each team shall participate in each stage. Each member of the participating teams is required to participate in at least one stage of testing during the whole selection process.

A written test will be held in the **first stage**. Individuals and teams demonstrating superior safety knowledge will be selected. The written test, consisting of 40 multiple choice questions, is divided into two sections. The five best performing individual participants and the five best performing participating teams will enter the second and third stages of testing with the endorsement of the adjudication panel.

The second and third stages of testing will be held on the same day. **The second stage** is a trade test while the third is an interview. During the trade test at the second stage, individual participants or one member from each shortlisted team will have to carry out inspection and testing to an electrical installation to find out defects in the circuit. The adjudication panel will assess the working procedures and performance of individual participants or members of shortlisted teams in aspects of safety and technical standards.

During the interview at **the third stage**, individual participants or one member from each shortlisted team are required to present to the adjudication panel, in any format, a proposal for enhancing electrical work safety at site. The proposal may include the electrical hazards encountered in the course of daily work and the solutions. If an individual participant or a shortlisted team chooses to submit the proposal in the form of a written report, a PowerPoint presentation or a video, such information may be submitted two weeks before the interview date (photos or audio-visual material in Chinese or English, if any, may also be submitted. If submitted by e-mail, each mail should not exceed 10MB). The assessment is mainly based on the content of the proposal. Apart from the electrical work safety proposal, assessment of the work safety awareness and level of technical know-how of individual participants or members of shortlisted teams will also be made during the interview.
