### Terms of Reference

- (a) The VMTAC advises on the following:-
- (i) development of the registration and renewal requirements for implementation of the registration scheme, as well as the relevant administrative arrangements;
  - (ii) means to encourage vehicle mechanics to participate in the registration scheme;
  - (iii) identification of training opportunities that are relevant to the registration scheme, as well as other training issues related to the registration and renewal requirements;
  - (iv) implementation of a monitoring mechanism to uphold the standard of services provided by registered mechanics; and
  - (v) review of the effectiveness of the registration scheme.
- (b) The VMTAC determines appeals made by any person aggrieved by a decision or action by the Vehicle Maintenance Registration Unit of the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department.
