2) 7.4 – Identification of EMO	Specified in clause 7.4.1	New requirement of evaluation of the implementation and energy performance of EMOs in respect of previous energy audit(s) is introduced in clause 7.4.1 (g)
3) 8.1 – Information for Report	Specified in clause 8.1	New requirements of information to be included in energy audit report, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Comparison of the current EUI with the EUI of previous energy audit - Energy consumption and evaluation of EMO(s) implemented in respect of previous energy audit(s) are introduced in clause 8.1(a), (g) and (m) respectively
