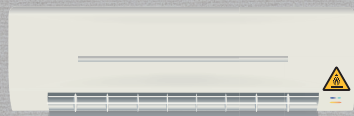


Voluntary Registration Scheme for Technicians Handling Mildly Flammable Refrigerant of Household Air-conditioners

HOW TO APPLY FOR REGISTRATION OF TECHNICIAN HANDLING MILDLY FLAMMABLE REFRIGERANT OF HOUSEHOLD AIR-CONDITIONERS

Purpose of the Registration Scheme

The use of mildly flammable refrigerant, with a flammability of class 2L according to the safety classification of the international standard ISO 817, in household air-conditioners is becoming common in the household air-conditioner market in Hong Kong. With a view to enhancing the practices and safety awareness of handling mildly flammable refrigerant of household air-conditioners, the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department has introduced a voluntary registration scheme for technicians handling mildly flammable refrigerant of household air-conditioners for the air-conditioning and refrigeration trade. Technicians in possession of necessary qualifications and experience in connection with the installation and / or repair of household air-conditioners using mildly flammable refrigerant may register under the scheme, which is voluntary in nature at the present stage.

Registration as a registered technician handling mildly flammable refrigerant of household air-conditioners indicates that the technician has completed relevant training and possesses adequate knowledge on mildly flammable refrigerant, and has competence in carrying out relevant work in the registration class he / she applied for. In addition, registered technicians shall undertake to follow a set of code of conduct and be monitored under a performance monitoring system. The scheme recognises the competency of technicians handling mildly flammable refrigerant of household air-conditioners and encourages more technicians to receive relevant safety training, with a view to uplifting their professional image. The public can also check online the list of registered technicians under the scheme.

Registration Classes

Under the scheme, there are 2 registration classes for technicians handling mildly flammable refrigerant of household air-conditioners as shown below. An applicant shall only apply for either of the registration classes:

Class	Work that the technician is qualified to carry out
A	Installing window type air-conditioners using mildly flammable refrigerant ^{Remark 1}
B	Installing household air-conditioners using mildly flammable refrigerant ^{Remark 1} and carrying out relevant work processes involving handling mildly flammable refrigerant ^{Remark 2}

Remark 1 : Types of household air-conditioners using mildly flammable refrigerant covered by the registration scheme include window type, single split type and multi-split type, with cooling capacity not exceeding 12kW. The registration scheme does not cover variable refrigerant flow (VRF) system.

Remark 2 : The work processes include installing split type air-conditioners and repairing refrigerant pipework of air-conditioners.

Registration Requirements

For registration under Class A, an applicant shall possess the following qualifications and work experience:

- (a) Completed recognised training course(s) ^{Remark 3} and obtained relevant certificate(s); and
- (b) Possessing a minimum of 6 months of experience ^{Remark 4} in installation of window type air-conditioners.

For registration under Class B, an applicant shall possess the qualifications and work experience under one of the following routes:

Route 1

- (a) Completed recognised training course(s) ^{Remark 3} and obtained relevant certificate(s); and
- (b) Possessing a minimum of 2 years of experience ^{Remark 4} in installation of single split / multi-split type air-conditioners and / or carrying out relevant work processes involving handling refrigerant of air-conditioners ^{Remark 2}.

Route 2

- (a) Completed recognised training course(s)^{Remark 3} and obtained relevant certificate(s);
- (b) Completed a registered contract of apprenticeship under the Apprenticeship Ordinance (Cap. 47) in the air-conditioning and refrigeration trade; and
- (c) Possessing a minimum of 1 year of experience^{Remark 4} in installation of single split / multi-split type air-conditioners and / or carrying out relevant work processes involving handling refrigerant of air-conditioners^{Remark 2} after completing the apprenticeship.

Route 3

- (a) Completed recognised training course(s)^{Remark 3} and obtained relevant certificate(s);
- (b) Passed the Refrigeration / Air-conditioning / Ventilation Mechanic (Unitary System) Trade Test (Skilled Workers) of the Construction Industry Council; and
- (c) Possessing a minimum of 6 months of experience^{Remark 4} in installation of single split / multi-split type air-conditioners and / or carrying out relevant work processes involving handling refrigerant of air-conditioners^{Remark 2}.

Remark 3 : Recognised training course(s) includes courses on household air-conditioners using mildly flammable refrigerant organised by the suppliers of household air-conditioners using mildly flammable refrigerant or the Vocational Training Council. For information of recognised training, please visit the Department's website (www.emsd.gov.hk).

Remark 4 : Relevant work experience must be obtained in the past 4 years.

Registration Renewal Conditions

Registration and renewal for each time is valid for 3 years. A technician applying for renewal of registration shall possess at least 1.5 years of relevant work experience in the registration class applied for and shall have a record of at least 10 hours of continuing professional development training within the last 3-year registration period.

Who May Register

A technician who fulfills the above registration requirements may apply to register as a registered technician handling mildly flammable refrigerant of household air-conditioners. An applicant can apply for any one of the registration classes as long as he / she possesses the requisite qualifications and / or experience for the relevant registration class. Only one registration class shall be applied for.

How to Apply

For registration as a registered technician handling mildly flammable refrigerant of household air-conditioners, application should be made to the Registration Unit for Technicians Handling Mildly Flammable Refrigerant of Household Air-conditioners of the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department. The application procedures are as follows:

- (a) Obtain an appropriate application form (**Form 1** – new application for registration) by the following ways:
 - (i) by downloading from the Department's website (www.emsd.gov.hk); or
 - (ii) by writing to the Registration Unit for Technicians Handling Mildly Flammable Refrigerant of Household Air-conditioners of the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department by post to 3 Kai Shing Street, Kowloon, Hong Kong, by fax to 2576 5945 or by e-mail to fr.safety@emsd.gov.hk (please provide contact telephone number and state the required application form, i.e. Form 1).
- (b) Complete the application form according to the Guidance Notes for Completing Form 1 enclosed with the application form.
- (c) Submit the completed application form together with supporting documents and materials by either of the following ways:

- (i) post to the Registration Unit for Technicians Handling Mildly Flammable Refrigerant of Household Air-conditioners, Electrical and Mechanical Services Department, 3 Kai Shing Street, Kowloon, Hong Kong;
- (ii) email to (fr.safety@emsd.gov.hk).

[Note: Renewal application should be submitted at least 1 month before and no earlier than 4 months before the expiry date of the current registration.]

Interview Arrangement

The Registration Unit for Technicians Handling Mildly Flammable Refrigerant of Household Air-conditioners may arrange an interview with an applicant to verify that the documents submitted are true copies of the original documents and confirm the qualifications and experience of the applicant.
