- Further encourage the electrical trade to foster innovation and cultivate a safety culture, and thereby enhancing electrical safety.


Eligibility*


- The participant can participate individually or as a team. However, at least one participant or a team member must be a registered electrical worker;
- Participants must not have been convicted or disciplined under the Electricity Ordinance or its Subsidiary Legislation in the past three years.

Participants who fail to meet the above eligibility requirements may have their enrolment cancelled.

Entry Requirement

- All entries shall produce a video with the theme of improving the electrical working environment and raising awareness of electrical safety;
- All entries shall be made with the use of any video recording equipment (including the mobile phone). The total duration of the video is about 1 minute;
