- 2) With regard to the Pilot Scheme on Building-Integrated Photovoltaics (BIPV) launched at the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department Headquarters, what are the current progress and implementation timetable? What mechanism is in place to access the effectiveness and feasibility of BIPV?
- 3) What measures have been introduced to support the use of RE by public and private organisations in the past 5 years (2020-21 to 2024-25)? Please set out the manpower and actual expenditure involved in each measure.

<u>Asked by</u>: Hon KAN Wai-mun, Carmen (LegCo internal reference no.: 50) Reply:

1), 3) and 4) The Government has earmarked a total of \$3 billion to install small-scale renewable energy (RE) systems at government buildings and infrastructure since 2017-18. As at December 2024, about \$2.2 billion have been

approved for over 260 small-scale RE projects, including the installation of solar photovoltaic systems at government offices, government quarters, schools, recreational grounds-cum-rest gardens, reservoirs, pedestrian links as well as the installation of waste-to-energy and hydropower systems at multiple sewage treatment plants. Of the approved projects, 190 have been completed and the rest will commence works as scheduled in the coming year. We expect that upon completion of these projects, a total of about 26 million kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity will be generated annually.

The RE projects completed at government buildings and infrastructure supported by the above funding in the past 5 years and the RE projects expected to commence in 2025 are set out in **Annexes I** and **II** respectively. As the management, operation, as well as repair and maintenance of the above RE projects are undertaken by individual departments, we do not have information on the actual electricity generation, amount of electricity tariff saved, performance in reducing indoor energy consumption, as well as repair and maintenance costs.

Furthermore, the Government has endeavoured to create favourable conditions to encourage various sectors to develop RE on their land and properties. For example, the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department (EMSD) launched a scheme called "Solar Harvest" between 2019 and 2024 to assist non-government and non-profit-making schools as well as welfare non-governmental organisations to install solar energy generation systems. A total of 716 solar energy generation systems were installed at about 500 premises, including nearly 470 non-government and non-profit-making schools, under the "Solar Harvest" over the 5 years from 2019 to 2024.

The Environment and Ecology Bureau also continues the collaboration with the EMSD to regularly organise activities such as seminars and briefings to introduce the installation of RE facilities and the Feed-in Tariff Scheme to relevant stakeholders, so as to encourage different sectors to utilise their premises for the development of RE. In the past 5 years (2020-21 to 2024-25), the EMSD organised and participated in nearly 120 public and trade briefings/seminars, with about 13 000 participants in total. Other work carried out by the EMSD includes continuously updating the HK RE Net to provide the public with relevant information, guidance notes and technical guidelines on RE, and setting up an enquiry hotline to answer enquiries from private organisations and the public in relation to RE, and offer technical advice.

Other than the "Solar Harvest" concluded in the end of March 2024, the EMSD will continue to forge ahead with the aforementioned work in 2025-26. Such work will be implemented by relevant departments like the EMSD with the existing staffing.

The Government is implementing the Pilot Scheme on Building-Integrated Photovoltaics (BIPV) (Pilot Scheme) at the EMSD Headquarters to explore

photovoltaic technology applications on the facades of buildings as well as the supply of RE to buildings. The objective is to assess the effectiveness and feasibility of BIPV having regard to the relevant data collected under the scheme, such as the actual power generation efficiency, performance in reducing indoor energy consumption, as well as repair and maintenance requirements and expenditures, so as to evaluate whether to extend the scheme to other public and private organisations in the future.

The first part of the Pilot Scheme involves conducting a feasibility study on the project, which was completed in December 2024. The second part involves installing a BIPV system at the EMSD Headquarters. The relevant works have been officially commenced in January 2025 and are expected to be completed in mid-2025. Afterwards, the EMSD will collect data of one year for subsequent evaluation.
