As mentioned in the previous issue of RVM Newsletter, the “Vehicle Maintenance Easy” platform, officially launched by the Vehicle Maintenance Registration Unit (VMRU) of the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department (EMSD), contains information on more than 1 000 registered vehicle maintenance workshops (RVMWs) in Hong Kong, facilitating searches by different users (including private car drivers, electric vehicle (EV) owners, and goods vehicle and bus fleet managers). It integrates all key information into a clear and user-friendly interface, significantly reducing search time. This issue will introduce the main search modes and functions of the “Vehicle Maintenance Easy” platform and demonstrate how to use it to find professional and reliable RVMWs.

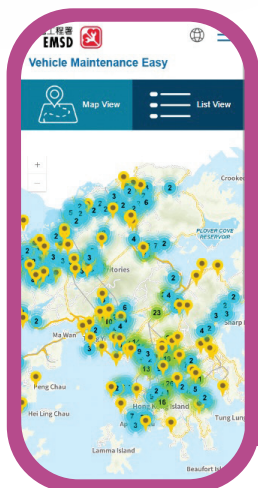

User Guide to the “Vehicle Maintenance Easy” Platform (Taking Android system as an example)

1. Map View

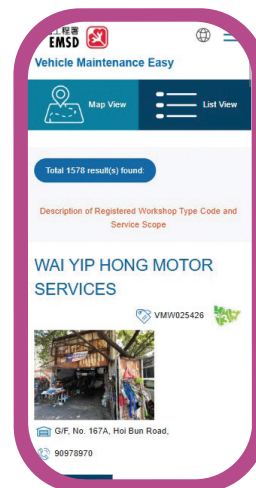
The platform homepage is set as the “Map View” by default. Users can pan or zoom in and out on the map to pinpoint an RVMW in a specific district or location. By clicking a yellow geotag on the map, the name, workshop type, registration number, address, contact number and photo of the selected RVMW will be shown underneath. By clicking “Detail”, users can view the type of vehicles serviced, service scope, type of service, opening hours and registration expiry date. Users can also use the “Route Click here” function, coupled with mobile phone positioning, to plan out the best route to the RVMW.



The homepage is set as the “Map View” by default. Clicking a geotag will give an overview of the RVMW.

2. List View

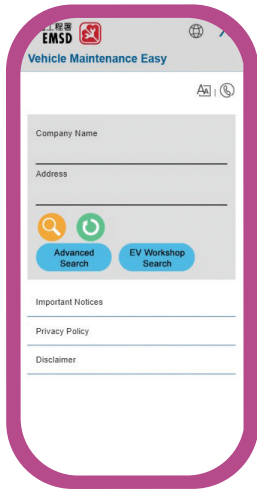
On clicking “List View” at the top right of the homepage, the page will switch to a list format. All RVMWs are arranged by registration number from newest to oldest, showing names, workshop types, addresses, contact numbers and photos for easy browsing. As in the “Map View”, users can click “Detail” and “Route Click here” to access information on RVMWs and plan out routes.



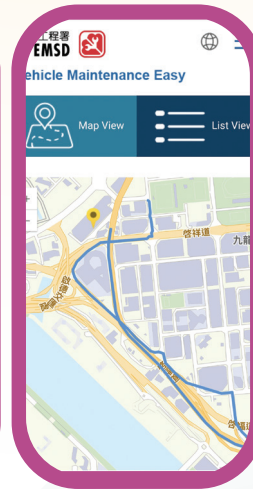
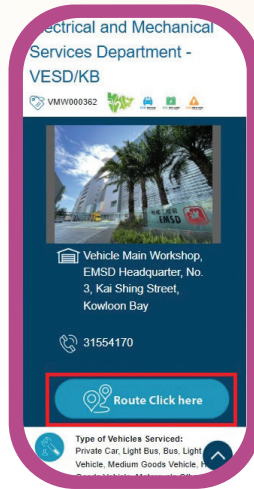
Upon switching to the “List View”, the information on RVMWs is arranged in order by registration number.

3. Search Mode

Users can click the “≡” icon at the top right of the homepage, enter the company name or address keywords of an RVMW, and then click the “magnifying glass” icon to conduct a search. RVMWs that match the search criteria will be shown with yellow geotags in the “Map View”, whereas the search results will be presented in a list in the “List View”. The subsequent steps are the same as above.



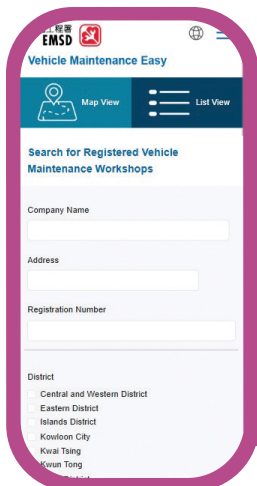
Enter the company name or address keywords of an RVMW in the "Search Mode" to search for the required RVMW information.



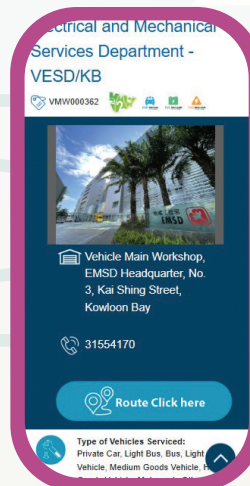
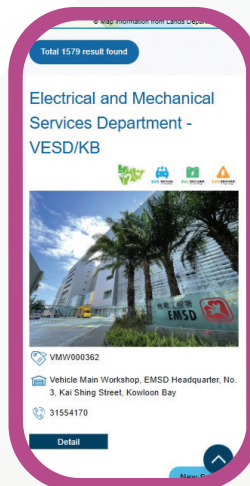
By clicking "Route Click here", the platform will provide the best route to the RVMW with reference to the Transport Department's information.

4. Advanced Search

The "Advanced Search" function allows users to enter the company name, business address or registration number of an RVMW and apply criteria such as district, type of vehicles serviced, service scope, type of service or opening hours to further filter the required RVMW information.

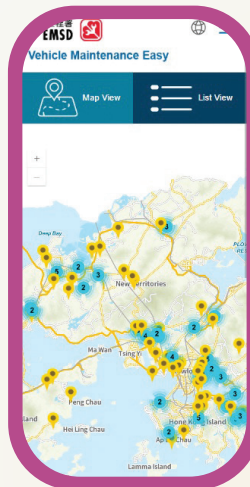
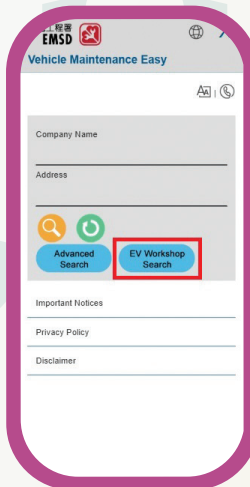


Enter filtering criteria on the "Advanced Search" page to pinpoint RVMWs that best meet the requirements.



5. EV Workshop Search

In response to the popularisation of EVs, the EMSD added EV maintenance service classes to the Voluntary Registration Scheme for Vehicle Mechanics and the Voluntary Registration Scheme for Vehicle Maintenance Workshops in July 2024. After clicking "EV Workshop Search", the page will immediately redirect to the "Map View". RVMWs providing EV maintenance services are shown with yellow geotags, while those only providing maintenance services for internal combustion engine vehicles will not be displayed. The subsequent steps are the same as above.



After clicking "EV Workshop Search", the page will show the locations of RVMWs providing EV maintenance services.

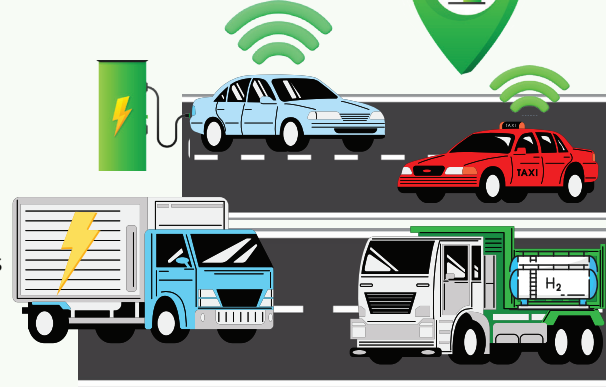

- 2 If a vehicle maintenance workshop intends to change its registration type or update its registered information (e.g. workshop name, registration number, address, contact number, or business registration certificate number, etc.), the person-in-charge of the workshop should notify the VMRU in writing within 14 working days of such change and submit the supporting documents for processing.

Furthermore, requests for conversion from a registered Type One, Type Two or Type Three workshop to a Type Four workshop will not be entertained.
2. Applicants should affix sufficient postage and provide a return address when posting renewal application forms with envelopes not provided by the EMSD.
