**Note 2 :**

- ★ + ★★★★★ No non-compliance found in both safety and services quality aspects in two recent quarterly announcements (Safety Star awarded and the services quality performance index at 100 points in the two recent quarterly announcements)
- ★ + ★★★★ No non-compliance found in both safety and services quality aspects (performance index at 100 points in this quarterly announcement)
- ★ + ★★★ No non-compliance found in safety aspect and service quality performance index is between 90 and 99 points
- ★ + ★★ No non-compliance found in safety aspect and service quality performance index is between 80 and 89 points
- ★ + ★ No non-compliance found in safety aspect and service quality performance index is between 70 and 79 points
- ★ No non-compliance found in safety aspect and service quality performance index is less than 70 points

In choosing a registered lift contractor for provision of maintenance services, apart from the price, the responsible person should also consider the registered contractor's background and scale, specific technical knowledge, availability of spare parts, maintenance work details, time required, emergency response capability, as well as the latest performance rating. After considering these factors, if the responsible person decides to choose a registered contractor with no safety stars or with fewer quality stars under the Contractors' Performance Rating for provision of maintenance service, the EMSD suggests that the responsible person should step up the management and supervision of contractors' performance. For instance, the responsible person may specify in the contract a requirement for regular submission of operational reports of the lift with analysis of the working conditions, failure rates and failure modes. The responsible person should also hold regular meetings with the registered contractor and review the contractor's performance. If necessary, the responsible person should consider engaging an independent consultant to provide independent professional advice.

- Note 3a :** An incident involving a lift maintained by Ben Fung Machineries & Engineering Ltd. occurred on 8 April 2018 at the Waterside Plaza, Tsuen Wan, resulting in serious injury of two passengers. The technical investigation has been completed. The investigation report has been uploaded to EMSD's website. - Ben Fung Machineries & Engineering Ltd. has been served with warning letter in relation to the non-compliance found in safety aspect in the incident. The record of non-compliance will be kept for one year until 7/2019.
- Note 3b :** An incident involving a lift maintained by Eugene Engineering Co. Ltd. occurred on 11 May 2018 at Paris Court of Sheungshui Town Centre, resulting in the death of one passenger. The technical investigation has been completed. The investigation report has been uploaded to EMSD's website. - Conviction by the court for contravention of section 16(1)(a) of the Lifts and Escalator Ordinance, Cap. 618. Eugene was previously served with two warning letters due to non-compliance found in safety aspect. The records of non-compliances will be kept for one year until 6/2019.
- Note 3c :** Disciplinary Board has completed the disciplinary hearings against Fujitec (HK) Co., Ltd. for misconduct and neglect under the Lifts and Escalators Ordinance. The board determined Fujitec to have committed five disciplinary offences in 2016 involving excessive clearance of rope retainers at 5 locations. Fujitec was ordered to pay a total fine of \$200,000 and the costs of proceedings, and the order was published in the Gazette on 7 December 2018. Upon the board's decision, Fujitec was served with a warning letter. The record of non-compliance will be kept for one year until 12/2019.
- Note 3d :** Conviction by the court for contravention of sections 16(1)(a), 16(1)(b) and 16(2) of the Lifts and Escalators Ordinance, Cap.618. Lighthouse was previously served with warning letters due to relevant non-compliances found in safety aspect related to the conviction. The records of non-compliances will be kept for one year until 5/2019.
- Note 3e :** Non-compliances found in safety aspect, thus served with two warning letters. The records of non-compliances will be kept for one year until 11/2019.
- Note 3f :** Non-compliance found in safety aspect, and conviction by the court for contravention of sections 16(1)(a), 16(1)(c) and 16(2) of the Lifts and Escalators Ordinance, Cap.618, thus served with two warning letters. Both records of non-compliance will be kept for one year until 2/2019 and 4/2019.
