Circular No. 6/2018

Periodic Brake System Overhaul Maintenance for Lifts

In recent months, there were lift incidents involving unintended car movement or ascending car overspeed that have led to serious injuries and fatalities. They have raised the grave public concern over the quality of maintenance works for lifts.

This circular serves to remind you that the effective and proper operation of the brake system is essential and critical to lift safety. You, as the registered maintenance contractor of lifts, are reminded of your statutory obligation and due diligence on conducting proper maintenance for lifts, in particular the proper conduction of brake system overhaul so to ensure the safe operation of lifts.

Brake system overhaul shall be carried out properly in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations and shall include, but not limited to, thorough checking and cleaning, timely replacement of worn out parts, adjustment, measurement and testing on the whole brake system, especially for brake plungers and associated mechanism, including brake pads, brake pressure springs, spacer rings, brake coil supply voltages and brake control systems. All the checking / measurement/ testing results, fault records and spare part replacement records shall also be well documented.

Moreover, you are reminded of your statutory obligation and due diligence in training and supervising frontline workers to ensure that they strictly follow the maintenance requirements as outlined above, and their works are carried out in safe and proper manner. Supervisory checks shall be well planned and checking records shall be properly documented. This Department will, from time to time, carry out surprise inspections and take necessary enforcement actions against the concerned registrants should contravention to the Lifts and Escalators Ordinance (Cap. 618) are identified.
